Intakes: Applications are taken all year with commencements in May, June, July and October, limited to 25 per intake. The programme is suitable for single people. There are opportunities available for working couples and applications for couples will be negotiated by NZDC on a case by case basis. If your first choice of intake is not available we may defer you to the next available.

Process: The application process will include an initial interview by telephone, Skype or face to face, followed by a detailed questionnaire. If you qualify, a face to face interview will be arranged with a New Zealand Dairy Careers



Pay Rates: You will be paid full industry rates as well as provided accommodation (or paid an allowance); the only deductions are income tax (currently 19%*), paid directly to your bank account weekly or fortnightly. In the dairy industry wage rates begin at \$35,000 per year, however NZDC candidates start out at \$38,000 for those with less experience, and go up to 45,000 for those with a considerable level of experience.
